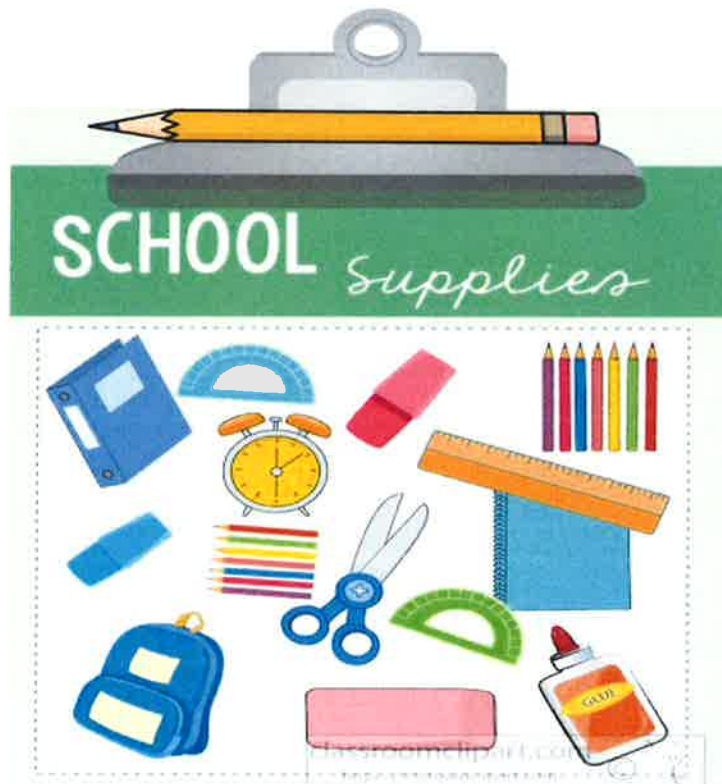

# Food Pantry News



During June 2018, we served the following numbers of people in the food pantry:

<u>MONTH</u>	<u># PERSONS</u>	<u># HOUSEHOLDS</u>
JUNE	4,231	1,118

We distributed 30,272 lbs of food during the month, and we spent \$1,114.63 on food. Our average cost per pound of food was just over five cents. So far in 2018 we have served 13,312 households, consisting of 24,522 people. Also, we have distributed 243,680 pounds of food, at a cost of \$12,181.67, an average of just five cents per pound.

**We are now receiving food deliveries/pickups every day of the week. All of this food has to be carried into the food pantry, weighed, and stored properly. In addition, many of the boxes are full of mixed product that must be sorted before we can put it on the shelf.**

We need someone to make the Tuesday and every other Thursday pickup from Harvey's at Edgewood & Moncrief. Several of these pickups are being made by people who are already very busy in the food pantry on a regular basis. Please pray about it and ask the Lord if you should step up a couple days a month to make some of these food pickups. You will be surprised how great it makes you feel that you are helping to provide food for the Lord's needy. You need a pickup truck or van to make these pickups. Even if you could only pick up one day a month it would still be helpful. If you can help please contact Tom Culverwell.

Thank you for the donations of paper and plastic bags. We continue to have to purchase paper & plastic bags. Your donations of paper and plastic bags will help us by lessening the number of bags we will have to purchase.

We appreciate any food donations, but we can stretch a dollar a lot farther than you can by buying food from a supermarket. By partnering with Feeding Northeast Florida Food Bank, and Waste Not Want Not, we are able to get approximately \$20.00 worth of food for every \$1.00 donated

In addition to your financial support a total of 958 man-hours were donated to the food pantry in June. Each volunteer hour has a value of \$18.85 on each volunteer hour performed; so the 5,198 volunteer hours donated in 2018 is equal to a donation of \$97,982.30!

God continues to provide everything needed to run his food pantry, but we need more manpower help. Because of the layout of the food pantry we cannot just move a pallet of food from the parking lot into the pantry. Each box or case must be hand carried inside and then sorted out and stored. We do use hand trucks, but it is still very labor intensive. Please pray about this and if you can spare only a few hours per week, we can use your help.
