At the Wednesday evening Lenten bible studies, we have been looking at and discussing the events of the last week of Jesus' life from the time of his entry into Jerusalem, where he was heralded as the "Son of David" to Gethsemane, where Jesus would pray before his betrayal and arrest that would lead to his crucifixion on the cross. This last week of Jesus' life is known as the week of Jesus' Passion due to his suffering.

Several times I have made, or the comment was made that we are people on the "other side" of the cross. That is to say that we are a post-crucifixion people and more importantly a "Resurrection people." In our study, I have reminded folks that the people who were eyewitnesses of the earthly Jesus did not know what was going to happen to Jesus. They had their expectations of who the Messiah would be as God's anointed savior of Israel and they would have to decide if this Jesus of Nazareth would "fit the bill" so to speak.

Prior to the Cross and Resurrection the Jewish people, and all nations for that matter (see Isaiah 56), lived under the covenant of the Law. In the Cross and Resurrection a new covenant has been given to all people through the sacrificial death of Jesus for our sins and redemption, and of a new life that Jesus brings to us in the Resurrection. The Cross and the Resurrection are dependent on one another. Without the Cross there would not be a Resurrection. Without the Resurrection the Cross has no meaning.

Yet, as a "Resurrection people", just as with the people on the front-end of the Cross, we have a choice to make whether we are going to live in the covenant that God has given us through Jesus Christ. The week of Jesus' Passion is a reminder of the sacrifice that God made for all people through the death on the Cross of God's son out of love for the forgiveness of our sins and for our salvation. Easter is the celebration of the new life and New Covenant given to us and all people in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ!

Live in the gift of the New Covenant of redemption that comes from the Cross and in the new life in the Resurrection! God's grace and blessings to you this Easter!

Commitment Sunday was November 18, 2018 when Trinity's congregation gathered for 1 service to praise God and to make their Capital Campaign and 2019 Annual Giving commitments. 60 initial pledges were made to the "FROM THIS FOUNDATION OUR MINISTRY GROWS" capital campaign. Since that time, additional pledges have been received. Trinity's children alone have contributed \$626.00 (through their "piggy banks" + Bean Soup Starter sales). As of February 20th, the current contribution total is \$401,035.00 which puts us over our goal for the "FROM THIS FOUNDATION OUR MINISTRY GROWS" campaign! SUPER! Isn't that great?! Congratulations!

Food Pantry News



During February 2019 we served the following numbers of people in the food pantry:

We distributed 43,376 lbs of food during the month, and we spent \$588.10 on food. Our average cost per pound of food was just over 4 cents. So far in 2019 we have served 2,195 households, consisting of 7,921 persons.

Thank you for the donations of paper and plastic bags. We continue to have to purchase paper & plastic bags, but we have identified a local supplier who is selling us paper and plastic bags at a very good price. Your donations of paper and plastic bags will help us by lessening the number of bags we will have to purchase.

We appreciate any food donations, but we can stretch a dollar a lot farther than you can by buying food from a supermarket. By partnering with Feeding Northeast Florida Food Bank, and Waste Not Want Not, we are able to get approximately \$25.00 worth of food for every \$1.00 donated.

We need around \$2,500 each month to pay for the food we receive from Feeding Northeast Florida, and to cover other expenses such as utilities, pest control, and security monitoring. So please pray about supporting the food pantry financially.
