

## Food Pantry - November 2019 Report

During November 2019 we served the following numbers of people in the food pantry:

MONTH - NOVEMBER # PERSONS - 3,839 # HOUSEHOLDS 992

We distributed 31,267 lbs. of food in November, and we spent \$444.60 on food. Our average cost per pound of food was about 4 cents per pound. So far in 2019 we have served 18,607 households, consisting of 40,215 persons. We have distributed 397,540 pounds at a cost of \$6,873.38.

We are asking once again that you save your egg cartons and bring them into the church when you can. We have begun receiving eggs again and need all the cartons we can get.

We continue to struggle with a small amount of

financial donations each month. We have a balance at Feeding Northeast Florida to pay for the route end deliveries, but when that money is expended we have no more funds to send to FNEF, which means the route end deliveries will end.

Please consider giving something to the food pantry each month. We are working very hard to keep the cost of procuring food low, but we have other expenses that must be paid monthly.

The Lord continues to give us everything we need to keep his food pantry operating, but we could use some more volunteer help.

We also need to pray for the Lord to give us a solution to our financial shortages.

# Praying Together: A Spiritual Journey for Lent

During Lent, we will have the opportunity to learn two treasured ways of praying.

Centering Prayer is a silent prayer method that prepares us to receive the gift of contemplative prayer and experience God's presence within us. This experience becomes closer to us than breathing, thinking or even human consciousness itself. Centering Prayer does

not replace other forms of prayer; rather, centering prayer deepens other forms of prayer and helps them move from active forms to more receptive forms of prayer, resting in God. Thus, Centering Prayer emphasizes prayer as a personal relationship with God, not just mere conversation but rather communion with God.

Lectio Divina, literally "divine reading" or "praying the scriptures,"

involves allowing God's scriptures to penetrate your heart and change you. This action is similar to Paul's urging: "Let the mind be in you that was also in Christ Jesus" (Phil 2:5, KJV). Lectio Divina is a spiritual journey filled with challenges, discoveries and, yes, love. Lectio Divina leads believers to a deeper awareness of God's presence in scriptures and what the scriptures can mean in their lives today.

## FROM THIS FOUNDATION, OUR MINISTRY

After one year into the "From This Foundation, Our Ministry Grows" capital campaign, here is a summary of the campaign and the work progress:

- Through November 30, 2019 \$172,638 has been given toward the \$400,745 pledged for the three year campaign;
- To date, \$41,558 has been expended for project costs; \$15,192 for Sanctuary re-wiring, \$13,242 for the campaign expense, \$449 for Sanctuary gutter removal, and \$12,675.00 for MIF loan closing costs.
- Roofing project of all buildings will begin on January 6, 2020.
