The month of April was a very busy time for me. I spent one weekend as a spiritual director for the Men's Via de Cristo weekend, and another week being away on vacation at the beach with family. Then there was the funeral service for Clarence Walker. We had two spaghetti dinners, one to benefit the Riverside Chorus and the other for the Children's Enrichment Workshops (CEW). I am ready for some yard therapy, tending to flower beds and repotting plants around the house.

It was timely to also receive a letter of appeal from Lutheran Social Services of Northeast Florida (LSS) encouraging financial support and to "Grow Hope in our Community." In the letter, Bill Brim (President & CEO), gave recipients little paper seed hearts to plant and grow and to also give "Hope" to people who are food-insecure, newly arrive refugees, individuals with an HIV diagnosis, or wanting to take control of their financial future. I plan to plant the little seed hearts and to continue our support of LSS for the coming year(s) along with planting seeds of hope this year through the work and ministries of Trinity.

There is an often used saying in Via de Cristo, that encourages one to "*Bloom Where You are Planted.*" Where we may be planted may change overtime, yet we are still called as followers and disciples of our Lord to "*bear much fruit*" for the glory of God (*John15:8*).

My hope for you this spring and summer is to continue to plant seeds of hope in Jesus Christ in your life and for the lives of others. My hope is that those seeds would bear much good fruit for the glory of God.
