

From Our Pastor

"Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. Whoever comes to me will never be hungry, and whoever believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)

I speak this first verse to everyone to whom I take Holy Communion. August is "bread month" as our gospel readings for the month are from the sixth chapter of John's Gospel. The sixth chapter begins with the feeding of the five thousand and the scripture passages we will hear each of the Sundays in August will focus on the feeding's aftermath. Jesus begins by paralleling himself with God's feeding the Hebrew people with manna, who were in the wilderness following the Exodus from bondage in Egypt. From there, Jesus goes one step further and expounds his teaching and claim. He now offers himself as the "Bread of Life" and as the "Living Bread from Heaven" by projecting what was to come in the instituting of Holy Communion at the Last Supper. In faith we share in the eating of bread, the body Jesus Christ, and in the drinking from the cup of salvation believing in the one who came down from heaven is the giver of life now and everlasting.

I never learned how to bake bread, but I love the smell and taste of freshly bake bread. Who doesn't! But while the bread and food we eat sustains our physical needs, it is the Spirit that gives to us life through the love and compassion of the risen Christ. Whether it is in our feeding ministry of the Trinity Food Pantry, in our fellowship lunches at church or in the breaking and sharing of bread at Communion, we are to pay attention and are to be renewed in life through the life-giving body of Jesus Christ.
