

From Our Pastor

One of my favorite (if not original) sayings that I use on the golf course is that "A one putt covers a multitude of sins." Believe me, I can in Luther's words, "sin boldly" when it comes to hitting that little white ball from tee to green!

There are two places in the letters of scripture where we hear about what covers a multitude of sins. One is in the letter of 1Peter where we hear that love covers a multitude of sins:

"Above all, maintain constant love for one another, for love covers a multitude of sins." (I Peter 4:8)

The other is in the very last verse of the letter of James where it says:

"...you should know that whoever brings back a sinner from wandering will save the sinner's soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins." (James 5:20) I certainly have been known to have wandered off into the woods and the weeds on a golf course and have needed saving!

During the month of September, my Sunday morning messages will be emphasizing themes from the letter of James (a book of which Martin Luther was not too keen). These themes I have named as being: "Doers of the Word", "Dead Faith", "Taming the Tongue", "Wisdom from Above", and "Prayer of the Faithful." They are all about living in and with the grace of God leading us and in keeping us in the "fairway" of life and out of the "weeds" of sin. So, come as we study and hear God's word of grace this September from the letter of James, and may a multitude of sins be covered by the love of God and our love for one another.
