Worship Service: February 8th, 2026, at 10 a.m. The Worship Music Leader will be **Deacon Ryan K. Hostler**, he serves as Minister of Music and Worship at Our Savior Lutheran Church in Vero Beach, Florida. Ordained in the Florida–Bahamas Synod in 2015, he leads a growing music and worship ministry for all ages. Ryan holds bachelor’s and master’s degrees in Music Education from the University of South Florida, a Master of Arts in Church Music and Liturgy from Trinity Lutheran Seminary, and national Orff certification. Prior to his call at Our Savior, he served churches and schools in Haines City and Tampa. A published composer and contributing author with Augsburg Fortress, Ryan has helped design worship for synod and churchwide gatherings, including serving as chair for Synod Assembly Worship and the ELCA Churchwide Assembly. His love for church music was shaped by Lutheran Summer Music and his lifelong formation in the Lutheran church.


